- Craft a Compelling Impact Section: Understand how to prepare and write the Impact section of your Horizon Europe proposal to maximize its potential.
- **Integrate European Policies**: Understand the importance of European policies and effectively address them within the Excellence, Impact, and Implementation sections.
- **Leverage AI for Grant Writing**: Gain a comprehensive overview of how AI can support and streamline your grant writing efforts.
